
SELECTION CRITERIA

- Set up in 1957, the IUFRO provenance test network has demonstrated the benefits of the Sudetes origin for its vigour, late budburst and low susceptibility to canker.
- The components of the orchard were selected from the natural stands of the Sudetes Mountains, in Poland and the Czech Republic.
 The + trees were chosen for their remarkable phenotype (vigour, straightness and branching).
- All the clones were recently genotyped and inoculated/canker tested.
 These 2 tests guided the thinnings of 2015 and 2022, with the objective of increasing straightness and resistance to canker by an additional notch.



GENETIC GAINS

 The evaluation test at La Courtine, in Creuse, compares the progeny of the Theil orchard with the well-known stand of Ruda (Czech Sudetes): after 25 years and 2 silvicultural thinnings, the progeny of Theil shows a marked improvement in straightness and vigour (+19% in volume).
